Frajan Elizabeth Payne, was born August 29, 1932 in Jonesboro, Tennessee to the late Louis D. and Lucille Birdwell Brown. She departed this life on Sunday, February 12, 2023.

At the age of five, Frajan moved to Brooklyn, New York. During her early years she attended schools in New York City and went on to further her education at Queens College, where she obtained both her Bachelors and Master's degrees. Throughout those years, she met and married her husband, Hastings Payne in 1950. From that union they conceived 10 children; Chlotealle "Kuwan" (who preceded her in death), Dana, Jarell, Jodi, Whitney (who preceded her in death), Hastings II, Martin St. Dennis (who preceded her in death), and Paige.

Frajan was known by all to be incredibly studious, hardworking, and quick witted. After completing college, she held job positions, such as a Police Administrative Aide for the New York City Police Department for 15 years and Assistant Director of Human Resources at the Department of Social Services, where she retired in 2008.

In 2012, Frajan decided to relocate to Waldorf, Maryland. She loved reading, watching Old Western movies, and spending time with family. She also enjoyed catching up with family at annual summer family reunions.

Frajan was the second oldest of the five Brown girls; three of which preceded her in death (Chlotealle Vivian Brown Granger, Loretta Brown Feggans, and Roslyn Brown Harvey).

She leaves to cherish her memory her children, Dana Payne, Jarell Payne Sr., Jodi Payne, Hastings Payne II, and Paige Payne I; 31 grandchildren; many great-grandchildren; one sister, Janith Murray; 1 brother-in-law, David Murray; 1 son-in-law, David Watts; 1 daughter-in-law, Marguerite Payne; and a host of nieces, nephews, cousins and friends.
