Richard Dallas Garland (Crazy Richard), age 65 of Piney Flats, TN passed away unexpectedly and was welcomed into heaven on Thursday, June 13, 2019. He was born on September 18, 1952 to the late, Dallas and Betty Garland of Johnson City, TN. He was a 1971 graduate of Lamar High. He was a long-time servant to the Church of Jesus in Johnson City where he put his bass guitar talent to use as well as leading Sunday School. Richard was a cut-up and enjoyed a lighthearted time with everyone he met. His family describes him as a devoted son, a loyal friend, a supportive husband and a committed father as the song by Brad Paisley says, "The Dad he didn't have to be."

Back in the day, most people knew Richard as "Crazy Richard" because of his early career using that dynamic voice over the airwaves at Sunshine 79 Gospel Radio. He continued his love for encouraging others through being a referee for basketball games and local wrestling. Later, Richard made a 28-year career working at Stowers Machinery and also part time work at Food City when retired early due to illness. During his retirement he volunteered his time at Bristol Regional Hospital, Kairos Prison Ministry (cake delivery), and disaster recovery teams (packaging food).

Richard Garland was an only child and preceded in death by his parents. He leaves to cherish his memories: his wife, Theresa, his two sons, Matthew McMillian (Rebekah), Adam McMillian (Alexis), his daughter, Angel Vereen

(Terrell), three grandchildren, James Bruner, Israel and Miracle Vereen.
