Willie E. "Fess" Norris, Jr., 91, passed on March 12, 2017. His final days were spent surrounded by family. He was born in Jonesville, SC, the son of Reverend and Mrs. Willie E. Norris, Sr. He was a graduate of Hampton University where he gained a degree in Automotive Services. He worked for TVA at Boone Dam. He was employed as a teacher in the Johnson City, TN school system for 36 years where he taught Brick Masonry and Auto Mechanics for the Johnson City Vocational School at Langston High School. He retired as an Auto Mechanics teacher at Science Hill Vocational School. He was a WWII veteran. He was an avid Dallas Cowboys and NASCAR fan. He was also known as "The Puzzle Man".

He was a member and served actively in a number of positions at Thankful Baptist Church. He was a charter member of the Pro-To Club. He was a member of NAACP, UMOJA, Washington County AARP, Iota Lamda Sigma fraternity, Washington County Retired Teachers, SALT, and Senior Saints. He was previously a board member of Boy Scouts of America, former director of Jackie Robinson Boys Club, and NACAT (National Association of College Automotive Teachers).

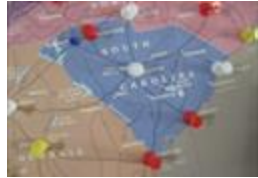

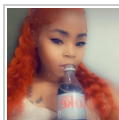
